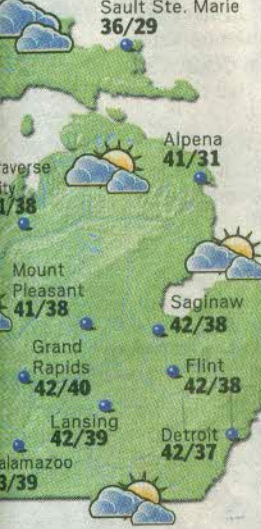

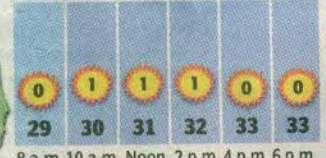

Macomb students earn honors in Website design competition

Fourteen young women representing Macomb County high schools shared in nearly \$3,000 in prizes in the ninth annual girls' website design competition sponsored by the Michigan Council of Women in Technology.

During the event, 12 finalists demonstrated their websites to a panel of IT executives who evaluated each presentation and the sites' clarity, functionality, graphic appeal, user-friendly navigation and innovation.

Macomb County students who earned recognition in the advanced category included:

- Christina Li, Utica Center for Math, Science and Technology, first place; \$750 and a summer internship at Comerica Bank;
- Jessica Old and Caitlin Beirne, Lake Shore High School; second place, \$500;
- Keyaria Walker, Lakeview High School; third place, \$300;

- Jackie Kwapisz and Brooke Glass, Lake Shore; honorable mention, \$75;
- Gabrielle Loprieto and Megan Kovalcik, Lake Shore; honorable mention, \$75.

In the beginner category, Macomb winners included:

- Catherine Makohn, Lakeview, first place, \$400;
- Kara Roelofson, Lake Shore, second place, \$250;
- Hailey Krause and Divine Mathes, Lake Shore, third place, \$200;
- Payton Beigler and Rachel Felder, Lake Shore, honorable mention, \$50.

The competition is aimed at encouraging, advancing and retaining women in Michigan's IT community. This year 103 teams, comprised of 144 young women from 30 Michigan high schools, enrolled in the contest's two divisions; beginners and advanced. Contestants could enter individually or with one other team member.
